

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



### Tick Tock Coin Clock


Use a paper plate and coins to make a coin clock. Instead of writing the numbers 1–12 on the clock, make the numbers out of coins. You can use 5 pennies or a nickel to make the 5. You can use 2 nickels or a dime to make the 10. Make arms for your clock out of construction paper. Draw a design on the paper plate to make your coin clock look cool!

### Busy Bank

Play “bank” with a friend. One of you can be the banker. The other person can be the customer. The customer can put money in the bank or take money out of the bank. The banker can also make change for the customer.

### Tic-Tac-Toe



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### Psychic Powers
